SHIPPING TO EGYPT

Egyptian customs authorities have issued new laws which will impact B2B & B2C shippers regardless of the shipment's value. Please refer to the key regulations summarised below:

- 1. Any shipments received in Egypt containing prohibited goods will be automatically returned to origin (RTO) or seized by Egyptian Customs for destruction.
- 2. Any consignments arriving in Egypt with incorrect shipment details on the AWB (Weight, Consignee Name, No. of pieces, Value) are subject to a penalty of 30,000 EGP (approx. £1,450)
- 3. If Shipper/Consignee requests a change to the Receiver Name, the shipment will be subject to a change fee of 30,000 EGP (approx. £1,450) linked to point 2 above.
- 4. The Consignee Name on the AWB & invoice should match exactly with the name of the Receiver on their national ID/ passport otherwise a penalty of 30,000 EGP (approx. £1,450) will apply.
- 5. If declared shipment value is understated by more than 20% as determined by Egyptian Customs, the shipment will be subject to a penalty of 50% of Duty + VAT amount.

Please ensure that you adhere to these regulations to avoid RTOs and penalty fees from the Egyptian customs authorities.
